

COLORAMA TOURNAMENT

COLORAMA is a Team Tournament where Players are assigned colors on the Official Scorecard.

The Official scorecard will have dots indicating the number of handicap strokes, if any, per hole.

The Players play their own ball until the hole out, and keep individual gross and net scores.

The TEAM will record TWO scores per hole.

The bottom of the flag stick will indicate the 'color' of the hole.

The Player whose color is the same as the color on the flag stick will record their Net Score, Plus the Lowest Net Score from the other Team Players, as the TEAM Score for that hole.

Four man teams will have four holes corresponding to each color, there will be two holes WITHOUT a color. On holes with NO color, the Team will record their TWO lowest Net Scores, as the Team score for that hole.

On Three man teams, three Players will have a designed color and there will be an unused 'ODD' color. The Player whose color is the same as the color on the flag stick will record their Net Score, Plus the Lowest Net Score from the other Team Players, as the TEAM Score for that hole. On holes with NO color, or the ODD color, the Team will record their TWO lowest Net Scores, as the Team score for that hole.

The Team Score will consist of the sum of the TWO scores recorded for each hole.
